



# Frequently Asked Questions

## RBC Capital Markets Scholarship for Women and Diversity Scholarship

### Q: Who is eligible for the RBC Capital Markets Scholarship for Women?

- Canadian Citizens or permanent residents of Canada
- Female students in full-time undergraduate studies graduating in December 2019 or Spring 2020, enrolled in a business, engineering, or economics program at an accredited Canadian university
- Students intending to continue their full-time undergraduate studies the following year
- Minimum cumulative 3.5 GPA/80%, or equivalent diverse extra-curricular participation and community involvement

### Q: Who is eligible for the RBC Capital Markets Diversity Scholarship?

- Canadian citizens or permanent residents of Canada
- Any male or female students who identify as visible minorities, Aboriginal or Indigenous background, LGBT+, veterans, and/or persons with disabilities currently in their second year of fulltime undergraduate studies, enrolled in a business, engineering, or economics program at an accredited university in Canada
- Students in full-time undergraduate studies graduating in December 2019 or Spring 2020
- Minimum cumulative 3.5 GPA/80%, or equivalent diverse extra-curricular participation and community involvement

### Q: What will I need to apply?

Complete your selected scholarship application form and include:

- A 300-word personal essay in support of your candidacy
- A current, one-page resume
- Relevant transcripts of your academic record

### Q: When is the deadline to apply?

Thursday, May 31st, 2018 at 11:59 PM EST

### Q: Are unofficial transcripts accepted during application submission?

Yes, we will accept unofficial transcripts as part of your application submission when official transcripts are not yet available.

### Q: How many RBC Capital Markets Scholarships are available to be awarded?

There will be up to 4 scholarships available for the Scholarship for Women, and up to 4 scholarships available for the Diversity Scholarship. Each is in the amount of CAD \$5,000.

### Q: When is the final scholarship decision made?

Shortlisted applicants will be invited to participate in first and final round telephone or in-person interviews in June and/or July at our Toronto office. All pre-approved travel expenses will be paid by RBC Capital Markets. Scholarship recipients will be announced at the end of the summer 2018.

### Q: Can a recipient accept the scholarship without accepting the offer of employment for the Summer Analyst position?

This scholarship is paired with the offer of employment to provide the opportunity to gain exposure to the Capital Markets business. Recipients must accept both the scholarship and offer of employment to receive either.

### Q: When would eligible recipients receive their C\$5,000 scholarship?

Winners will receive their C\$5,000 scholarship once they complete their summer placements just before their final year of studies.

### Q: I am a Quebec student and our programs are traditionally three years versus four. When am I eligible to apply?

Quebec students are eligible to apply in their first year of studies.
