## Frequently Asked Questions

- Q: Who is eligible for the RBC Capital Markets Diversity Scholarship?
- Canadian citizens or permanent residents of Canada
- Individuals who identify as any of the following:
  - Women
  - Visible minorities
  - I GBT+
  - Aboriginal or Indigenous background
  - Veterans
  - Persons with disabilities
- Students in the second year of full-time undergraduate studies graduating in <u>December 2020 or Spring 2021</u> from an accredited university in Canada
- Q: What will I need to apply?
- Completion of online application
- A 300-word personal essay in support of your candidacy
- A current, one-page resume
- Relevant transcripts of your academic record
- Q: When is the deadline to apply?
  Capital Markets Diversity Scholarship will open in Spring 2021
- Q: Are unofficial transcripts accepted during application submission?

Yes, we will accept unofficial transcripts as part of your application submission when official transcripts are not yet available before the application deadline.

- Q: How many scholarships are available to be awarded? There will be up to 10 scholarships available. Each is in the amount of C\$10,000.
- Q: When is the final scholarship decision made?

  Shortlisted applicants will be invited to participate in first and final round telephone or in-person interviews in June and/or July at our Toronto office. All pre-approved travel expenses will be paid by RBC Capital Markets. Scholarship recipients will be announced at the end of the Summer 2021.
- Q: Can a recipient accept the scholarship without accepting the offer of employment for the Summer Analyst position? This scholarship is paired with the offer of employment to provide the opportunity to gain exposure to the Capital Markets business. Recipients must accept both the scholarship and offer of employment to receive either.
- Q: When would eligible recipients receive their C\$10,000 scholarship?
  Winners will receive their C\$5,000 scholarship once they complete their Summer 2020 placements just before their final year of studies.
- Q: I am a Quebec student and our programs are traditionally three years versus four. When am I eligible to apply? Quebec students are eligible to apply in their first year of studies.
