



Fedwire and Swift Payment Changes

When: November 2026

What: The Federal Reserve (Fedwire) and Swift are removing support for unstructured postal addresses in wire payments. This is a significant operational change to wire payment formatting, affecting every organization that sends domestic or cross-border wire payments. RBC Clear™ will support both structured and hybrid address elements with no interruption to client payments processing.

Note: More than 60% of cross-border payments globally contain unstructured addresses, which will become non-compliant after November 14, 2026. Payment messages with non-compliant addresses will be rejected.

Deadlines:

- November 14, 2026 - Swift CBPR+ (all cross-border payments)
- November 16, 2026 - Fedwire Funds Service (U.S. domestic wires)

Next step: Contact your Account Manager to complete payment testing before the November deadlines.

Changes to Fedwire Payments

Effective: November 16, 2026

All Fedwire payments must use either fully structured or hybrid address formats. Fully unstructured postal addresses will no longer be accepted.

Compliant formats:

Option A - Fully Structured Address (Preferred):

- Every component in separate dedicated fields: street name, post code, town name, country
- Town name = Mandatory
- Country = Mandatory
- Sample: <TwnNm>Jersey City</TwnNm>
<Ctry>US</Ctry>

Option B - Hybrid Address (Alternative):

- Town name and country in separate structured fields (Mandatory)
- Up to 2 free-text address lines of 70 characters each for additional details (Optional)
- Structured info (town name and country) must not be duplicated in the free-text lines
- Phrases such as “not provided” should be avoided
- Sample: <TwnNm>Jersey City</TwnNm>
<Ctry>US</Ctry>
<AdrLine>30 Hudson Street NJ</AdrLine>

Changes to Swift Messages

Effective: November 14, 2026

Corporate Swift Members (SCORE/MACUG) will continue to use the single MT 101 format with the updated address guidelines:

- Must update messages to use Field 59, Option F for structured address requirements
- Must provide, at minimum, town name and country for creditor
- Messages which do not follow the address guidelines will be rejected by Swift

Sample

:59F:/US1234567890123456

1/COMPANY INC.

2/123 STREET NAME

3/15TH FLOOR

4/US/BIG CITY/88888

- Lines 1-3: Beneficiary name and street address details
- Line 4: Mandatory structured elements - Country code (US) / Town name (BIG CITY) / Postal code (88888)
- Note: Do not repeat City Name or U.S. in lines 2-3
